Chapter Ten

Wise Teachings

"Intuition is the sacred connection between your Self and your Creator. Since it is so, it must echo the truth that exists within your mind. It is innate that your intuition is the correct path to take, the correct voice to listen to, the right thing to take action upon. Instead, they took their problem and it became their solution...ignited by their endless imagination.

"It was their imagination of great things, of stardom, of fame that elevated them to where they earned the accolades that they deserved. They were a star in their own mind long before they were a star to others in the world. They shone brightly within long before they shone brightly without. We make so much of their ability, perhaps we should make much more of their imagination to be someone they never should have been if they had clung to logic and reason.

"I witnessed that when you are left with little but logic and reason...the sad winds cry out your name, the serene seas salty from their tears, the seething rivers convulse in motion. Are you unable to see that your dragons are shackled to their caves...captives; your hero grounded...flightless. I say to you – why wait until you have more breaths behind you than in front of you to release the dragons? Do it now! Why wait to unbind the hero? Do it now!"
